Field Trip — Saturday, August 13

Full Moon Rising Over Elm Lake—Brazos Bend State Park

On August 13, the moon is full and it rises at 7:54 p.m. We will meet in the Elm Lake parking area at 7 p.m. and walk a short distance to the west side of Elm Lake where we will set up to photograph the moon rise across the water. At that time of day, you may also see alligators, birds, and maybe deer.

Moonrise is very nice at this location. Early in the outing you will begin shooting across part of the lake and through some trees. Birds are flying in to roost. Black Bellied Whistling Ducks, White Ibis, Egrets, and vultures are all candidates for a bird flying across the moon shot. Moonrise landscape photos are possible with shorter lens. But, for the *big moon* shots, you will want your longest lens.

An optional extension is a visit to George Observatory, also in Brazos Bend State Park. **Steve Goldberg** will provide a guided tour of those observatory areas open without a ticket. Steve and Amelia were involved in the selection of the site for this observatory and were Building Managers for nine years. They are experts on the facility.

Since the Perseid Meteor Shower occurs that evening, there will be lots of visitors to the observatory. Photo ops may be limited due to the crowds.
