This is a quick summary of some competition rules that have changed and will go into effect on September 1. Please refer to the HCC website for the complete rules.

• Number of images in Regular Competition

You may enter **two** images each month in the Regular Projected Image and in the Regular Print competitions. These competitions now have **four** categories: Pictorial, Nature, Photojournalism, and Travel. If you enter two images, they must be in different categories.

• Creative Competition

Creative Projected Image and Creative Print will now be separate competitions. Creative competitions will be held monthly. You may enter one image each month in each of these competitions.


