Armand Bayou Nature Center offers over 5 miles of hiking trails that take you through different ecosystems—prairie, forest and bayou. White-tailed deer are commonly sighted at the nature center, and there are a wide variety of songbirds. The interpretive center houses a variety of native reptiles and amphibians. The gardens include an organic vegetable garden, a Watersmart garden, a children's discovery area, a heritage garden at the Hanson House, and a prairie interpretive garden. Houston Camera Club Dues Now Payable


