# Outdoor Portrait Workshop—June 2

The portrait workshop will be held Sunday, June 2, at 6:30 p.m.. **Mark Katz** and **Joe Sandler** will lead the workshop. The spot we have chosen is a small lake with rocks and a fountain. Two models will be available.

Bring your tripod, a reflector, diffuser and a flash if you have them. For full frame cameras, the traditional lens for portraits is 85 to 135mm. Choose your lens according to your camera's crop factor. You may also want to bring insect repellant.

Directions: From I-10, take Eldridge Parkway south. After driving about 1/3 mile, turn east onto Enclave Parkway. The pond is located on Enclave about 100 yards north of Sandbridge St. There is parking across from the end of Sandbridge St and also a parking garage across Enclave from the lake.
