Cleaning Your Camera's Sensor

Has your camera been out in the summer heat and dust? Has it been at the beach or a lake with the salt spray and moisture?

Do you think your sensor needs help? Fall weather is coming and it is time give your equipment a good going over. And that includes your sensor, too.

Come to the September workshop and learn how to clean your sensor without damaging it. **Ross McEathron** will show you the correct way. He will have a sensor scope, a device that will help you see just how dirty your sensor is.

Bring the following supplies: a manual air blower such as a Giotto rocket air blaster (no canned air!), a sensor swab that is correctly sized for your camera and some sensor cleaning fluid. These supplies are available at Camera Exchange or the camera store of your choice.
