Workshop—January 21

Learn to Shoot Great Macros

If you have ever wanted to learn how to take great close-up images, this is the workshop for you! Cletus Lee will give us a short presentation on the equipment needed, tips for setting up your shots, and how to process macro images. We will spend the rest of the evening practicing macro techniques.

Bring your camera, flash unit(s), a tripod and a lens that has a short focusing distance. It is not necessary to have a "macro" lens. If you have close-up filters, extension tubes or a teleconverter, bring those along too. If anyone has lights or a tabletop studio, we would appreciate your help bringing those.
