### Workshop—May 20

## **Using Lightroom 5 to Edit Photos**

In this workshop, **Cletus Lee** and I will show you how to efficiently and creatively process your images using Adobe Lightroom 5. We will focus on editing photos, but will also talk briefly about keywording, copyrighting, and exporting.

Bring your laptop with Lightroom loaded on it. Also bring a camera card or flash drive with a handful of photos. If you don't have a laptop, you can pair up with someone who does, so that you don't miss out.

Lightroom is a stand-alone product from Adobe that does not require a Creative Cloud membership. The images should be named in the following manner:

W the number 1 or 2 image title maker's name.

Be sure to save a copy of your image after all your adjustments, but before sizing. If you win, you will need this copy to do the final sizing for the cover. The final winning image needs to be high quality and sized approximately 6 1/2" High by 5" wide.




