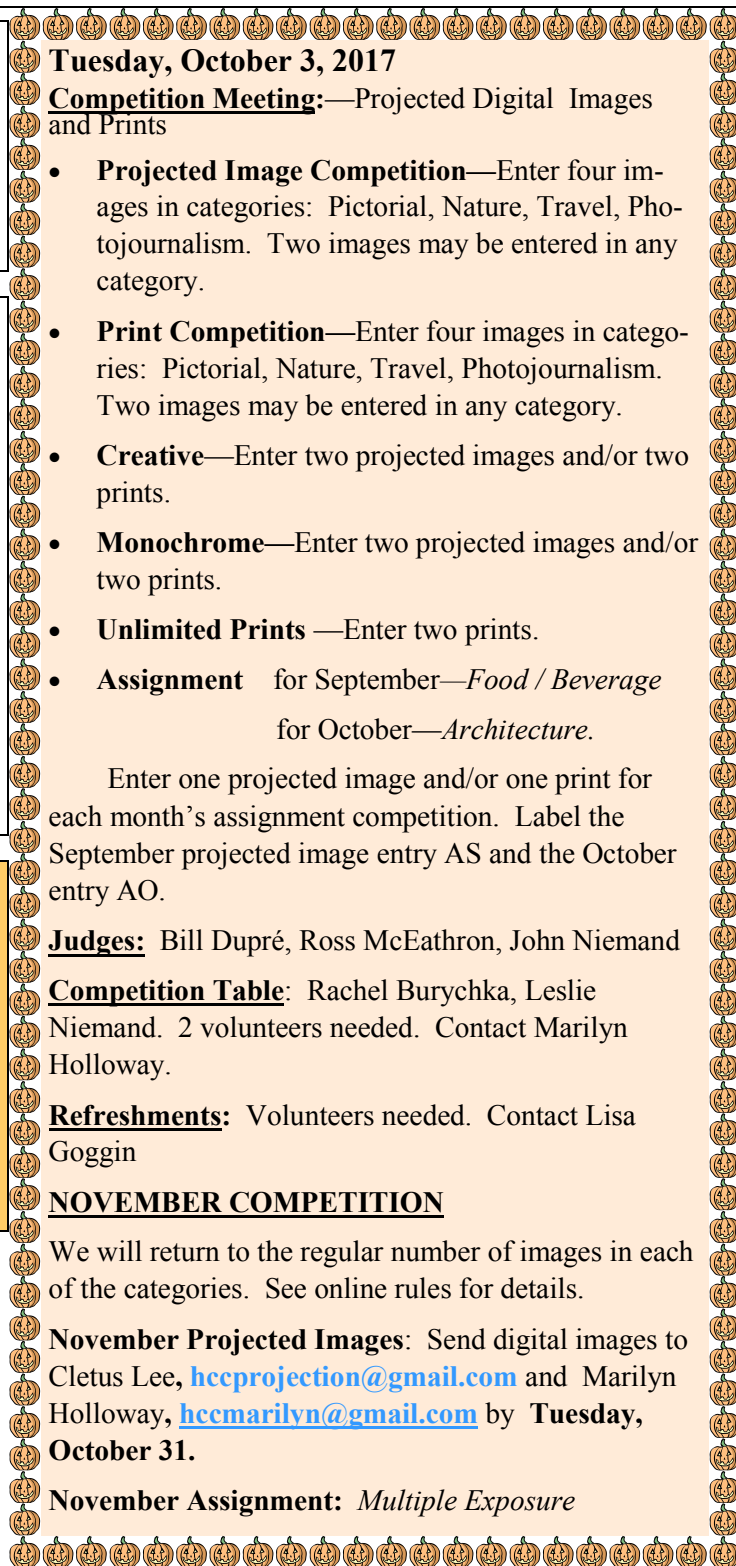

## Member News

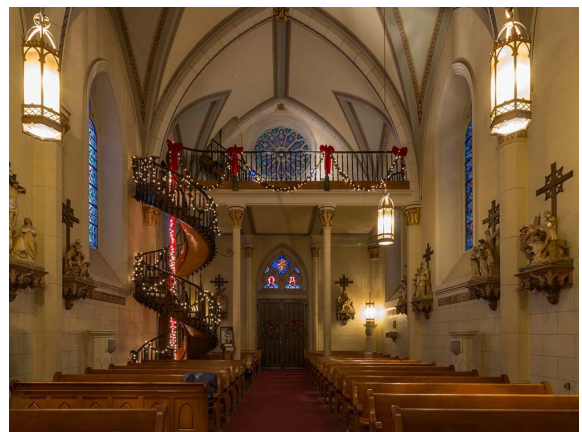
**Gerry and Bob Jump** continued their National Parks visits with a trip to Rocky Mountain N.P. in September.
