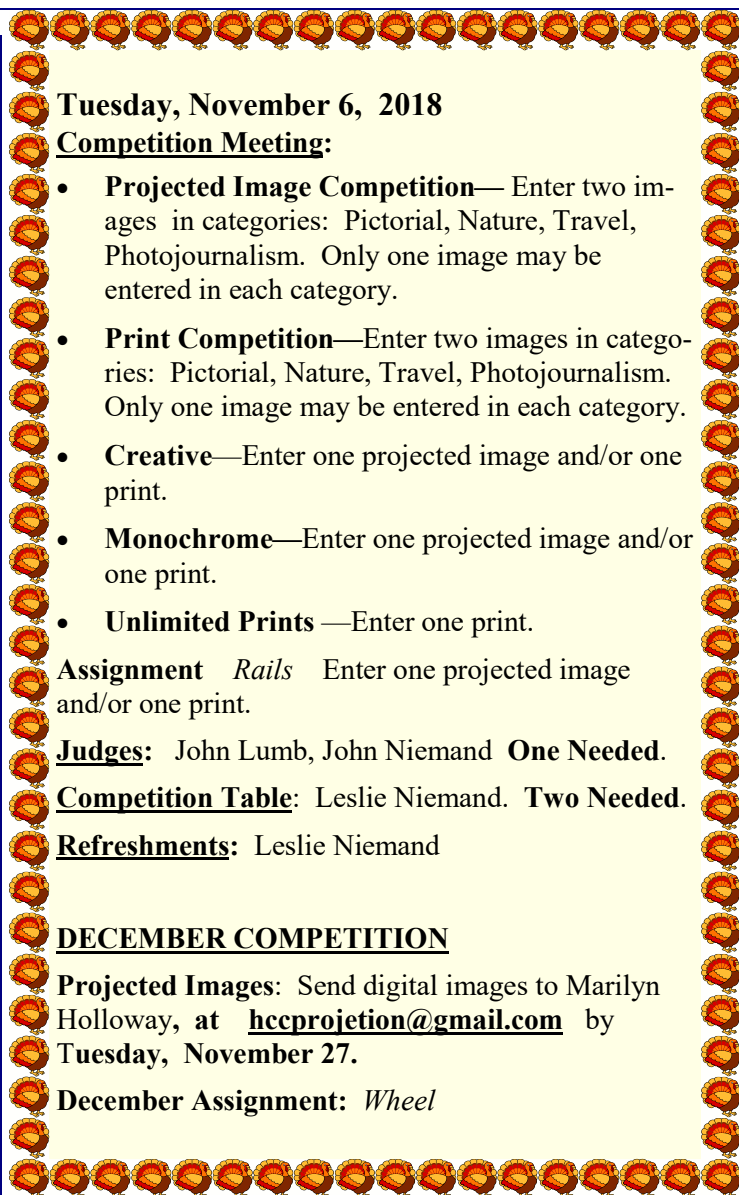

Your images need to be jpgs correctly sized. Give them names with the convention for the first image of a 1 followed by the maker's initials, for the second image, of a 2 followed by the maker's initials. Bring your images on a flash drive. We will project them and the group can discuss them.

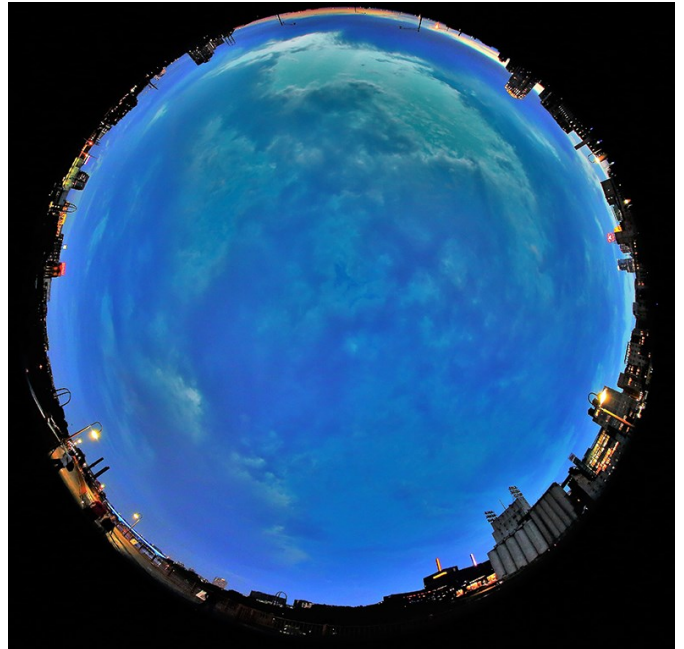

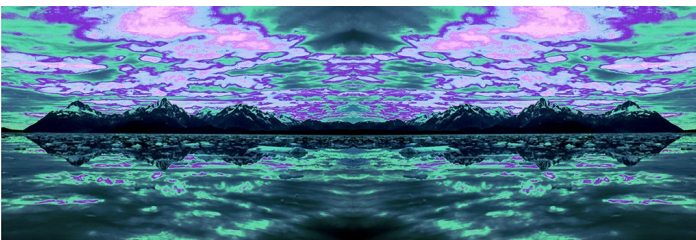

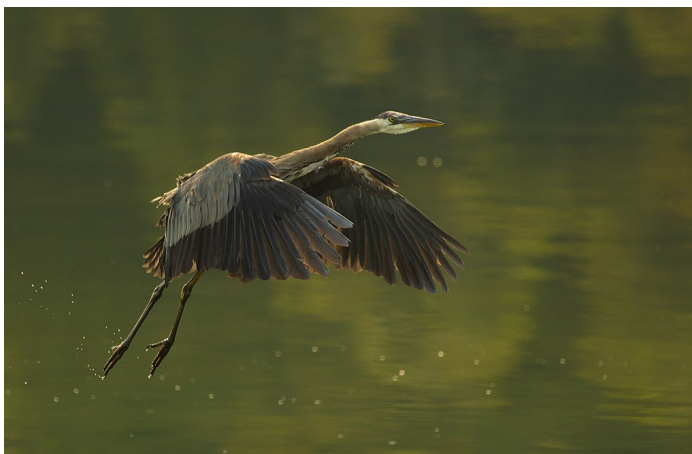
