Our field trip is to the **Houston Botanical Garden** for a special exhibit, **Radiant Nature**. The exhibit has spectacular larger-than-life Chinese lantern installations arranged in three areas of the gardens. This is an opportunity to bring your spouse or a friend along to see the show. There is food available and also shopping.

We will meet on Saturday, February 10 at 6:00 p.m. at the main entrance to the garden. The address is 1 Botanic Lane off Park Place Blvd in Houston. Don't be late. We will be there for sunset and the blue hour, but, no moon. The garden remains open until 10:00 p.m.
